Moojen Named 2005 Male Athlete of the Year

Cocoa, FL – Cocoa Expos leading scorer Fred Moojen was named the 2005 Lincoln Memorial University's Male Athlete of the Year at the University's annual Athletics Banquet held in April.

As a starter in all fifteen games for the Lincoln Memorial University Railsplitters, Moojen scored 23 goals and had 7 assists, totaling 53 points. He was ranked first in the nation in goals and second in points, helping lead the Railsplitters to their first ever Gulf South Conference Regular Season Championship.

Moojen received several honors in his first season including 1st Team All Conference, NCAA All-South Region, GSC All-Tournament and GSC Player of the Year. He was also recognized by his Railsplitter teammates, receiving Co-MVP for the 2004-2005 season.

After three games played in the 2005 United Soccer Leagues Premier Development League, Moojen is the Cocoa Expos leading scorer with 3 goals and 1 assist. He was named to the PDL Team of the Week on May 17, 2005 for his performance in the Expos 5-1 win over the Ajax Orlando Prospects on May 14, 2005 where he had a hat-trick and 1 assist.

The Cocoa Expos will be in action this Friday night, May 27, 2005 when they host the Bradenton Academics at 7:30 pm at the Cocoa Expo Sports Center in Cocoa, FL.
