

*Welcome to the Cocoa Expo 3v3 Summer Festival,
July 22-23, 2006 in Cocoa, Florida!*

We are looking forward to a great tournament. We want to make sure every team that has entered knows exactly what they need to do to be ready to have a great experience. Here are some important points for you to be aware of:

Application Deadline:

July 7th, 2006.

Tournament Fee:

\$152(\$20 team discount before July 7th)

Age Groups:

U6 to Adult

Format:

3v3 (up to 6 players per roster)

Minimum 4 games per team

All players will receive Tournament T-shirt

CHECK-IN:

- Friday evening July 21, 2006 from 6:00 to 8:00pm at the Cocoa Expo Clubhouse, where you will receive t-shirts for each player on the team. At least one member from each team must attend check-in!

What to bring:

1) WAIVER FORM - If you applied online, you MUST bring a WAIVER with player/parent signatures. You can also choose to print out the application form which has the waiver on it.

2) PROOF OF AGE

Make sure to bring PROOF OF AGE for each player to team check-in. (such as player passes, copy of birth certificate, driver's license, etc.)

3) APPLICATION - If you need to change your roster from the one that was submitted on your application OR If your original application was not filled out entirely (with all players addresses and birthdates) you must bring a final application to check-in. You can find a printable version on our website under printable application.

4) HOTEL FORM - if you are staying at a hotel please fill out the Hotel Form and turn it in during registration.

SCHEDULES: Schedules will be posted on the Cocoa Expo Webpage the week of the tournament.

MEDICAL RELEASE forms are important if a player under the age of 18, is injured and requires medical treatment and a parent or guardian will not be present to authorize treatment by a physician. You will not be required to present medical release forms at any time during the tournament, but they are highly recommended. If any of the players on your team will not have a parent in attendance, the coach should have a properly signed and notarized medical release form. BALL: Each Team is required to bring a game ball. The home team's ball will be used as the game ball. U6-U8 use size 3, U9-U12 use size 4 while U13 and older use size 5
